

Jeweled Bookmarks



Make "jewelry" for your most treasured books. (Actually, they're pretty bookmarks made from ribbon and beads.)

Supplies

- 12-inch piece of ribbon (double-sided satin works best, but you can use other types to suit your taste)
- Assorted beads
- Beading thread, such as Nymo
- Beading needle
- Fray Check (optional, to seal the ends of some ribbon)

Instructions

- 1. Fold under both ends of the ribbon twice and use tiny stitches to sew securely. Note: If you are using a heavier ribbon, you can use Fray Check to seal the cut end, and then just fold once and
- Sew lengths of beads to each end, mixing and matching colors and sizes. Be creative!
