MIRKWODD DESIGN& presents...

General block instructions:

- 1. Cut a 13-inch square of background fabric.
- 2. Trace and cut basket pieces from a fat quarter of fabric, remembering to add ¼-inch seam allowances.
- 3. Center the handle and the basket onto the background square and mark location.
- 4. Appliqué* the handle first, then the basket.
- 5. Mark where you want to put your leaves and flowers.
- 6. For gathered leaves**, cut four 4-inch circles.
- For large ruched flower**, cut one 1½ x 44-inch piece of fabric.
- 8. For small ruched flowers^{**}, cut two $1\frac{1}{2}$ x 22-inch pieces of fabric.
- 9. Sew on the gathered leaves, then the ruched flowers.
- 10. Trim the block to $12\frac{1}{2}$ inches.
